

### SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- 1. Oral and Poster Presentations are invited for the conference.
- 2. The word limit for the abstract is 300 words.
- 3. All submissions must be original and should not have been previously accepted for publication in any journal or presented in any other conference.
- 4. The abstract should be in English and structured as per the following headings: background, method, results/findings, and conclusion.
- 5. The abstract must include details of all authors, particularly their name, designation, affiliation, email address, and phone number. In case of co-authors, kindly mention the presenter's name.
- 6. We also welcome group symposium presentations of 1 hour having 4-5 presenters coordinated by 1 symposium chair. The abstract of the symposium should be maximum of 1000 words & should have a brief introduction of the symposium followed by individual abstracts. All abstracts must include the title, name, and affiliation of the authors, and they should be submitted as a single document by the symposium chair.
